PROJECT OVERVIEW

This ongoing contract with Industrial Dwellings Society (IDS) has involved the design, installation, refurbishment and upgrade of passive fire safety measures for a range of residential properties. Our specialist operatives have also delivered a range of fire safety-related tests and inspections, including across dry riser systems and other fire safety equipment.

SCOPE OF WORKS

Our teams work in partnership with IDS to design, install and upgrade passive fire protection systems. This includes fire compartmentation improvements in line with Fire Risk Assessments (FRA); installation of fire doors, intumescent vents, and fire-resistant glazing; class 'O' flame-retardant coatings applied to appropriate areas; and fire signage installation to comply with current regulations.

We also deliver maintenance and testing services for dry riser systems across multiple residential sites, as well as the routine delivery of annual pressure testing and six-monthly visual inspections. Our work covers a range of property types, including residential apartment blocks, residential developments, low-rise or mid-rise residential complexes and housing estates composed of multiple blocks.

All works are completed by our FIRAS registered operatives, working under AJS' FIRAS accreditation, while completed works are certificated under the FIRAS scheme.

This streamlined process facilitated clear communication among team members; reduced the risk of oversight; and promoted accountability. Furthermore, the centralized documentation and reporting features enhanced transparency and compliance, providing IDS with real time document access.

We also established a scalable resource and solid Business Continuity Plans to ensure a consistent service. A solid management team were also in place to oversee quality and safety of works, as well as maintain client relationships.
